










*Stuck on a word?

FIRST...

	<p>COUNT to three (1...2...3)</p>
 or 	<p>ASK Coaching or Time?</p>

Then, try these strategies...(more strategies on back of page!!)

 <p>I can see a pig.</p>	<p>See the picture? The word is right there.</p>
 <p>/p/ /i/ /g/ = pig</p>	<p>I can sound this word out with you.</p>
	<p>Chunk the sounds together.</p>
 <p>It is a delicious apple.</p>	<p>Skip the word and come back.</p>

 <p>It is a delicious apple.</p>	<p>Go back and reread.</p>
 <p>I like to eat cookies.</p>	<p>What word makes sense here?</p>
<p>Picture Sound it out</p>  <p>Chunk skip</p> <p>Reread makes sense</p>	<p>What strategies have you used?</p>
